3. What are some practical ways you can anchor your joy in Christ during difficult seasons?
4. Paul gives three warnings in one verse. Why is it sometimes necessary for spiritual leaders to speak strongly about danger?
5. What are some modern examples of people placing confidence in religion, morality, or good works instead of Christ?
6. Why is legalism so dangerous to true joy in the Christian life?
7. How can believers today stay spiritually alert without becoming harsh or judgmental?
8. According to Paul, what are the three marks of those who truly belong to God? Which one stands out most to you and why?
9. How does knowing we belong to Christ help protect our joy and security?
10. What does it look like in everyday life to “put no confidence in the flesh”?
