Pregnancy Support Center of Southside VA

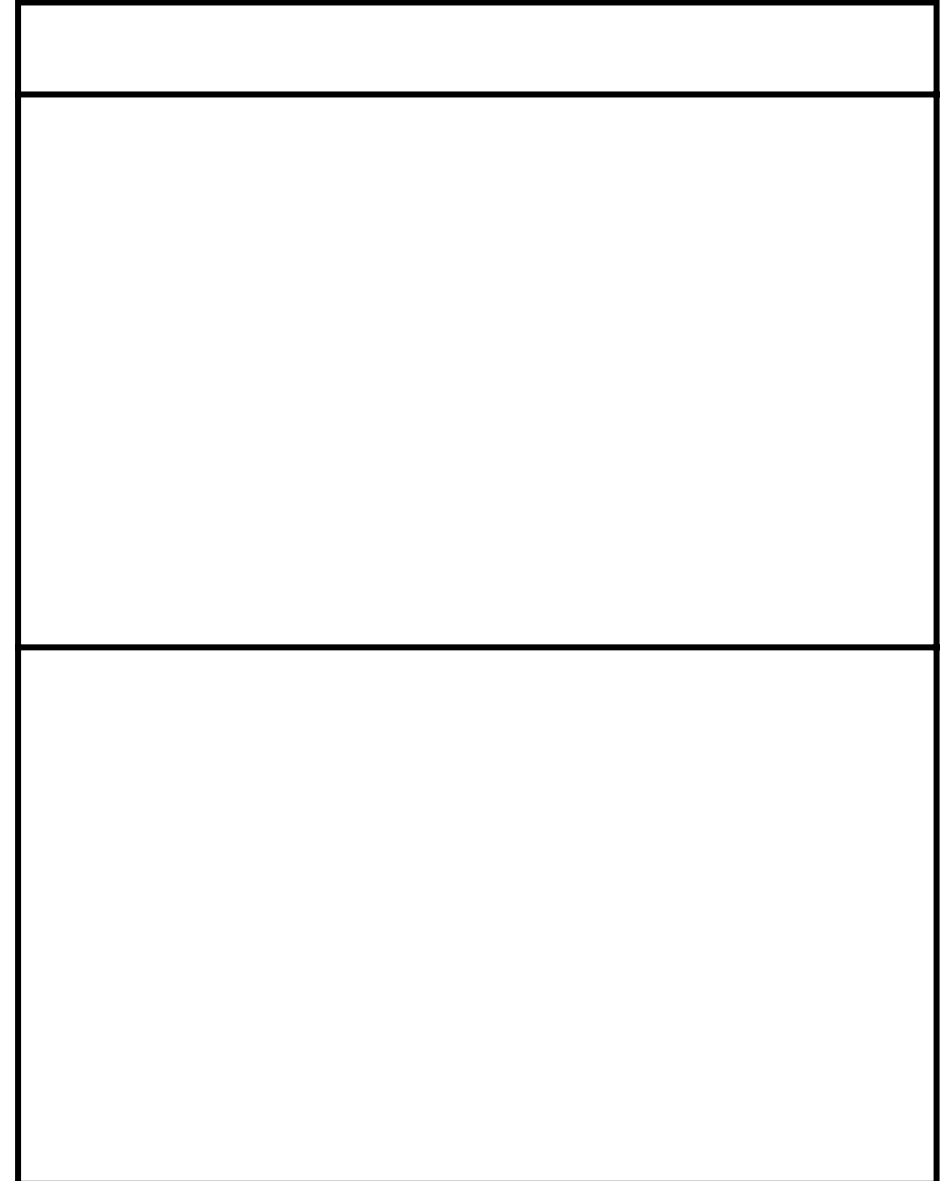
