Awana Theme Nights encourage a sense of belonging, establish a bit of fun, and some themes result in Clubber's earning Awana Bucks to spend at the Awana Store! Explanations of those nights are featured below.

<u>Pastor Appreciation Night</u> – Bring a card or note of appreciation for Pastor Mark. We will be presenting them to Pastor Mark after he speaks to us during Opening Ceremony.
