What is Christian Worship?

And Jesus answered him, "It is written, " 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve." Luke 4:8

When you read the question of the title of this week's Pastor's Pen, what was your first thought? Is worship just when we sing to Him on Sunday mornings? Does worship only happen in the Lord's house one day a week? The short answer is a resounding no.

The meaning of the New Testament Greek word most often translated as "worship" is "to fall down before" or "bow down before." But, worship is more than just falling or bowing down. Christian worship involves more than just singing praises to God on Sunday morning. Part of our worship includes our fellowship, the giving of our first fruits, deacon, and elder prayer, and the preaching of His word. However, while we gather as the bride of Christ each Lord's day to worship, that is not the only time we worship. The way we live our lives should be an act of worship. Paul puts it this way, "I appeal to you, therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship." Our worship should be on display every day of our lives. That is why Paul said, "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind." As our minds are transformed from worldly things to the things of God, we can begin to worship in spirit and truth. A true heart of worship should be the desire of every believer in Jesus Christ.

While we are in these mortal bodies are worship will never be what we want it to be or what it will be when we see our Lord fave to face. Distractions of many kinds can flood our minds as we try to praise and glorify God, hindering our true worship. Unconfessed sin can and will impair your worship of God. We serve a loving and merciful God that created you to glorify Him through your worship. So what say you, Christian? Will you get rid of the distractions in your life that hinder your worship? If you need to confess, do so now so that your unconfessed sin will not hinder your worship.

"Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire." Hebrews 12:28-29


Valley of VisionA puritans prayer
