Slave

Do you not know that when you go on presenting yourselves to someone as slaves for obedience, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin leading to death, or of obedience leading to righteousness? Romans 6:16

As Americans, we are taught from a very young age that we are the freest nation this world has ever seen. The evil practice of slavery ended in our nation over 150 years ago. However, even today, every person that lives is a slave.

When Paul penned his letter to the Romans, he made it very clear through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit that each of us is a slave. We are either a slave to sin or we are a slave to righteousness. The lost think that they are free and are not in chains. As Christians, we have been freed from the bondage of sin and are now slaves to Christ. Therefore, because we are His slaves freed from sin, we are truly free and have been granted the privilege of being called sons and daughters of God (John 1:12). When we understand that we are no longer slaves to sin, we have the power through the Holy Spirit to resist and refrain from habitual sin. When you did not belong to Christ, sin was your master. You were unable to resist it. But now, because you belong to Christ, "and having been freed from sin, you became slaves of righteousness" (Romans 6:18).

Christian, live in the freedom of your salvation, knowing that when you do sin, you have already been forgiven. This does not give us the freedom to continue sinning: "What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin so that grace may increase? May it never be! How shall we who died to sin still live in it?" (Romans 6:1-2). Our freedom from sin and death allows us to have joy in the midst of all the evil around us.

What say you? Whose slave are you? If you are a slave of righteousness, be encouraged by Paul's words:

"But thanks be to God that though you were slaves of sin, you obeyed from the heart that pattern of teaching to which you were given over, and having been freed from sin, you became slaves of righteousness. I am speaking in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness, leading to further lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness, leading to sanctification."

In choosing them, He acted WISELY, as He really desired to have them. For each one of them is ready to confess that if God had not chosen them, that they would never have chosen Him! The nature regulates the choice; and as our nature is carnal and impure, we would never have chosen God who is spiritual and holy.

His choice was just an early expression of His LOVE. The love which chose them, would do anything for them, and give anything to them! Therefore God spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for them all; and in so doing, gave them the assurance that He will also freely give them all things in Christ.
