Christ-centered Life!

"Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus is accursed," and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit." 1 Cor. 12:3

We know that regeneration comes before belief. We were dead in our sins and unable to respond to the Gospel. But God, in his mercy, calls us to be His. Paul makes that clear when writing to the church in Corinth. The Holy Spirit breathes new life into the elect, allowing them to profess that Jesus is Lord.

The Holy Spirit's role does not end in a believer's life after salvation. He indwells in every believer. Paul writes to the Romans, "However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him (Rom.8:9)." If you are born again, the Holy Spirit lives within you and allows you to live a Christ-centered life. The Holy Spirit is essential in the life of every believer.

The role of the Holy Spirit in our life.

He teaches us, "But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you (John 14:26)."

He seals us, "And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption (Eph. 4:30)."


He assists in our prayers, "And in the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness, for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words (Romans 8:26)."

He comforts us, "You also became imitators of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction with the joy of the Holy Spirit (1 Thes 1:6),"

He gives us the ability to produce spiritual fruit, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control (Gal. 5:22-23)."
